Literature, Cultures and Societies of the French-Speaking World (France and the Caribbean)

INTRODUCTION OF THE DIPLOMA

A / Benefit of this International University Degree

This International University Degree, "Literature, Cultures and Societies of the French-Speaking World", proposes to welcome students pursuing French studies and coming from foreign universities in the Caribbean Region / the Americas. This is for a maximum period of one year. They will receive 2 distinct certificates, one for each semester. The degree will permit them to obtain certain qualifications in line with the study programs of these universities.

B / Required Level

This University Degree is aimed at English or Spanish speaking students studying French as a foreign language and who are in the third or fourth year of their Bachelor Degree during their French studies [end of their bachelor]; who already have a very good command of the French language; but who wish to have an even better command of this language and have a more real approach to the French and French Caribbean Culture and Literature.

C / Organisation of the Course

This University Degree will stagger over 2 semesters, each with certification. The two certificates will then make allowance for the delivery of an International University Degree. These certificates can make it possible for students to obtain an equivalent qualification at their home university. The University of the Antilles and French Guyana is part of the ISEP network and has bilateral partnerships with other universities.

Number of working hours per semester: from 150 hours / students.

For each semester, the students have one compulsory language Teaching Unit (UE). They also have to choose 5 other Teaching Units (UE) from a dozen others proposed to them, in order to validate their certificate for the semester.

E / Cost of the course

Each diploma handed out per semester costs: **5968 Euros / 6564 US** This amount covers the following provisions:

- Registration fees
- All the Lectures, seminars and workshops for the 6 chosen Teaching Units (UE) and their logistics
- Accommodation transport from the airport to the university residences

Anticipated Expenses:

- Accommodation (possibility in university housing: 440 Euros for 1 month)
- Meals
- Transportation from university residences to the Campus.
